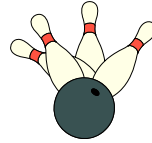

RULES

A bowler may participate only once in this tournament.

USBC RULES #319d and 319a are waived.

Bowlers must use previous years' highest book average. If no average use latest book average up to 3 years or current certified 21 game average. No certified average bowler must bowl scratch. Rule 319a-3 reporting incorrect average will be upheld. 10-pin rule applies, USBC rule 319a item 2, which states "when the previous season's average is used, and at the time of bowling an entrant has a current average for 21 or more games that is 10-pins or more higher than the previous season's average, the current average must be used".

Handicap will be 90% of 210.

Bowlers shall bowl (6)-games across 12 lanes to qualify.

Finals will be based on a Peterson point head to head 2-game match. **Dress code enforced.**

The top (12) teams will return for a semi-final round and bowl an additional (6) games with **no-carryover pin fall** to determine the top (7) qualifiers to join the defending champions. **In order to keep the tournament on schedule all squads will start at their specified times (excluding circumstances beyond our control). Any bowler not ready to bowl at the specified start time will receive a zero for every frame they miss. Alternates must report to the tournament director(s) 30 minutes prior to the start of semi-final and final rounds.**

In case of a tie for the last spot in qualifying or semi-final rounds there will be a one game roll-off to determine the spot.

The team in the (8)th qualifying spot shall be designated as an alternate to bowl in the finals if any team is unable to bowl for any reason.

If a team wins the tournament (3) times they must re-qualify the following year.

All teams shall bowl the finals with the same partners they qualified with.

A \$40.00 deposit is required for a reservation. No spot will be reserved without a deposit.

No refunds will be issued for no-shows.

All prize fees collected will be returned 100% to the participants of this event.

Prize ratio is at least 1 prize for each 10 entries or more.

Tournament director(s), Dan or Deb Sidon will settle all questions or disputes.
